Good News!

- COVID-19 Numbers have gone down dramatically
- Vaccinations are being rolled out to educators
- SBCOE are remaining healthy



COVID-19 Numbers

- Daily average positive cases is just over 10 cases per day over the past two weeks
- Positivity rate is below 8%
- New numbers come out on Tuesday



Surveillance Testing

- Employees who want to participate have been placed in two groups and informed about which group they are in
- Participating employees should register at <https://home.color.com/covid/sign-up/start?partner=cdph334>.
- Surveillance Testing will take place at SBCOE's Main Office, San Andreas/Santa Ana and ECE
- Information about the exact dates and times for surveillance testing will be sent out via email
- If you have tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 90 days, you should NOT participate in surveillance testing right now.



Vaccines

- Vaccines have begun to be available for educators in San Benito County
- Priority is begin given to educators who are in person
- Employees are encouraged to contact their doctor or pharmacy if they are one of the participating providers
- SBCOE will inform employees when it is their turn
